

Florida International University Financial Aid Statistics

Federal financial aid investments at FIU make a critical impact in South Florida, allowing our region to gain new college-educated professionals as these individuals work to pursue their dreams.

2019-2020 Highlights

- Over 23,493 FIU students received Pell grants in 2019-2020 .
 - This represents approximately 48% of our total student undergraduate population.
- Over 55% of Pell recipients receive the maximum award based on an expected family contribution of \$0.
- Sixty-seven percent or 12,904 of Pell recipients earned a B average or higher (3.0+) in Fall 2019 (based on Cumulative GPA).
- Seventy percent or 13,615 of Pell recipients are enrolled full time at FIU during Fall 19.
- 45% of FIU students receiving Pell are First Generation in college.
- FIU had 4,259 students who qualified for Florida Student Assistant Grant (FSAG) but didn't get an award due to lack of funding.
- In South Florida, 222,203 students receive Pell Grants at the sum of \$784,513,881.
- Total unmet financial need for FIU's enrolled undergraduates who filed a FAFSA and received at least one type of AID was just over \$273 Million (not including summer) for 2019-20 Source
- 18,393 students currently receive Stafford Loans
- \$19,705 is the average loan indebtedness (2020 CDS)

Work Study & Other Federal Aid Programs

- 771 students take part in the Federal Work Study Program
- 18,393 students receive funds from the Federal Direct Loan Program (FDLP)
- 2,951 students are recipients of the Supplemental Education Opportunity Grant (SEOG)

Default Rate

- Percentage of FIU borrowers defaulted on their Federal student loans within three years of entering repayment= 5.2% (National Average= 9.7%)
